This book contains autobiographical sketches in the form of a monthly diary of a person who chose to live close to nature during much of his lifetime.

Persons from twelve years and up should find the book easily readable with the exception of some names of animals and plants. It might well be placed in a public library, or perhaps a school library under the general area of ecology.

The black and white illustrations do not do justice to colorful nature.
